<u>"The solitude of Adam"</u> Synopsis

Background:

The play takes place in the period between the two world wars in Europe (though there's no reference in the text). Adam, the main character in the play, is a young European soldier serving in the army during the war. He is an orphan adopted by his uncle and aunt Leon and Marta whom are working as servants at Yohan's house, the popular Deputy mayor and a widower living with his daughter, Adrian. Yohan and Adrian are very rich, and as befitting for the status, Yohan pushes Adrian to marry Stephan, who is older than Adam and Adrian. Stephan is also rich and his family has always supported Yohan in his many political positions.

Since they were young, Adam and Adrian loved each other but always kept it a secret. Stephen, who is also in love with Adrian, did not know about the affair she has with Adam and was going to marry her upon his return from the war, despite her refusal.

Sequence of Events:

The play is presented in a manner that is not chronological (as in the movie "Pulp Fiction"), i.e. The order of scenes in the play does not reflect the chronological order of the events of the story and the plot goes back and forth in time. The audience meets with the characters in three different time periods.

The Plot:

First period: 1916. The train station, Evening. Adam, Stephen and Joseph, their commander, return for leave from the front. Stephan is close to his discharging while Adam only goes on vacation. On the platform, Martha and Leon, Adam's adoptive parents, are waiting impatiently. Karl, Stephen's personal assistant is waiting to take him home with his luxury car. At home, Yohan, a political activist, urges Adrian to marry Stephen, who returns as a war hero. Adrian's marriage has future political implications. Stephen is a man of means and influence who came from a well-connected family. Adrian insists on going after her heart and wait for Adam. As Adrian leaves her father`s office, his supporters enter in an effort to encourage him to run for mayor. During the discussions, which continue into the night, Yohan offers Commander Joseph the role of police chief if he will support him publically.

Adam meets with Adrian secretly in her father's garden. Stephen, who is also in love with her, is watching them. The discovery of the affair comes to him as a shock. He is furious, pulls out his gun and plans to kill Adam, but Leon, the servant, surprises him. The two struggles and Stephan shoots Leon and flees. Adam, who ran to see what had happened is caught by Yohan and Joseph who were interrupted by the gunshot. This is a good opportunity for Yohan to remove Adam and he incriminates him for a murder he did not commit. Karl, who had witnessed the murder, remains silent.

Martha, on her way to Yohan's office, hears Stephan confess and ashamed with guilt in the garden. In the Office, Yohan dissuade Adrian from helping Adam and asks her again to marry Stephen. Martha and Adrian plead Stephan to release Adam and look for the real killer. Martha tells him what she overheard from Stephan in the garden and Yohan, who needs Stephen, send the two away after Adrian tells him that she is pregnant with Adam's son. Without knowing the truth, that he is the real killer, Adrian finds solace in Stephen, works in his factory and lives with him. He helps her to raise her newborn, Thomas.

Second period: 10 years after the murder, Adam escapes from prison disguised as a policeman. Stephan and Yohan contract the murder of Martha to Karl, now chief of staff in Stephan's factory who remained loyal to him after the death of his father but also dislike him. They fear that Adam will come to Martha and she would protect him and together they could hurt them. Karl recruits the staff from the factory as they see him as their leader. One of the employees is Betty, Joseph's daughter and Karl's girlfriend. Anna, Betty's little sister, witness the conversation and payment transfers for the murder between Karl and Stephan. Karl and other factory workers try to hurt Martha in the city's alleys, but Adam, dressed as a policeman, arrives just in time to save her and goes with her to her home. Adrian recognizes him in the street but keeps a distance as she fears exposing him or harming their son, Thomas, who was born without his knowledge.

Joseph, Stephan and Yohan's good friend, who was appointed by them as the police chief, returns home drunk. He is a hardworking man who raised his daughters by himself after his wife ran away from them. He hears from Anna, who accompanied Betty all day and confronts Betty for being reckless in her care for her sister. Anna can't stand their shouting and runs out to the street where she meets Thomas, a childhood friend. Anna loves Thomas, son of Adam and Adrian but he is not mature enough to notice her affection.

Adrian tells Stephan she saw Adam in the market and asks his advice on what to do next. She was afraid to come to him directly as she can be accused of assisting a fugitive and then Thomas could be left without a mother. On the other hand it's an opportunity for her to meet Adam and tell him about his son. Her father and Stephen dissuade her from meeting Adam. Stephen urges her to avoid any contact with Adam until the issue is clarified but when she insists he offers her to write Adam a letter containing the whole story. He promises to summon Martha and forward Adam the letter through her.

At home, Martha tells Adam about Stephan's confession in the garden. She and the Adam are planning to testify against Stephen in Court. Adrian sends Thomas to tell Martha and Adam about the letter that awaits them with Stephan without his knowledge. Yohan is debating whether to run for head of the district as the country is on the verge of an economic crisis and a feeling of uncertainty fill the streets. Stephen hides the letter from Adrian in his table, calls the police to his house and gives away Adam's location to Joseph. He understands that as long as Adam is free he poses a danger to both of them. Martha decides to go out and retrieve the letter leaving Adam hiding in her house. She crosses paths with Karl and Betty. The two, who are thrilled to complete the job, catch her and hurt her badly, leaving her to drown in her own blood on the street. Adrian finds Martha, dying. With her last breath she tells her that someone is waiting for her at home. Adrian sends Thomas to call for help but it is too late. Martha dies in her arms.

Karl and Betty arrive at to Stephen's home to report on the death of Martha and collect the payment for their efforts, but instead of welcoming them, Stephen gets rid of them them in fear that any connection to them might tie him to the murder, and Karl, who was already ambivalent towards Stephan, promise to take revenge.

Adrian comes to Martha's house where she meets Adam. The police sent by Stephan are closing in on the house, Adam gets arrested and Adrian is shot by Joseph and dies before she can tell Adam about Thomas. Adam returns to prison, Thomas goes on to live under Stephan's care and grows up without knowing who his real father is.

<u>**Third period**</u>: 13 years after the death of Adrian, in 1939, Yohan trying to run for office as head of the district. He enlists Stephen and Joseph at his side. Karl, who leads a Group of workers fired by the plant and other factories due to the difficult economic

situation, confronts the corrupted and traitorous Yohan and Stephan (who invited him to murder). He wishes to try and recruit Anna's friend, Thomas, the son of Stephen, now a senior officer with public security, to his cause. Thomas confronts him and Anna, his childhood friend, who is still in love with him. Karl's attempt fails, they run away. Karl decides to take revenge at Yohan and Stephan by burning Yohan's house and the City Hall, if Yohan elected. Anna and Thomas fight. Anna is tired from the blind sighted tyranny of Yohan while Thomas argues that Karl is a charlatan.

That same year, Adam's Parole Board is convened and it is decided to release him from prison after 22 years. Thomas was appointed as his parole officer and finds Adam a job and a place to stay at his father's, Stephen, factory. They still do not connect the dots. The day Adam is released from prison Yohan wins the election. Yohan has regrets abandoning Adrian and his old, good intentioned, ways. Thomas tells him that he received information from Anna that Karl and his gang is coming for him. Anna, confused between her love for Thomas and the fight for justice by her sister, Betty, and Karl, decides to leave Thomas, who never showed her real love, and go out with Karl gang's vendetta against Yohan and Stephan.

Karl, Betty, Anna and the group of workers set out to blow up the winning party of Yohan and to hurt him. Right from the start they are discovered by Joseph, Thomas and the officers who are able to save the house from burning. Meanwhile, the operation in the town hall is successful and the building gets burned. Betty is accidentally shot and killed by her father in an attempt to save Karl while confronting one of the officers. Thomas binds Karl and Anna, and takes them to jail. They tell him that Stephen and Joseph are corrupted and are responsible for the death of Leon and Martha. Joseph, who lost one of his two daughters, believes them.

Yohan's victory party is held at Stephan's factory since the City Hall was burned. Joseph arrives at the party, drunk, and starts to publically accuse Stephan for the murder. Thomas comes to the party with Adam in an attempt to keep his promise, and introduce him to Stephen, his father. Stephan realizes what is happening, locks himself in the office and commits suicide, holding the letter from Adrian in his hand. Yohan, Adam, Joseph and Thomas burst into Stephan's office after they hear a gunshot, read Adrian's letter and find that Thomas and Adam are father and son and the mother is Yohan's daughter, Adrian.

<u>The plot scene by scene</u> <u>Act I</u>

Scene A :

March 1939, Adam, Tomas, Yohan and Josef are in Stephan's office after Adam's release from prison. Stephan sits dead in his chair while Joseph is pointing his gun at him (so it seems that he shot him). Adam and Tomas read the Adrian's letter which tells the story of their life and the relationship between them. Thomas, Yohan and Adam wonder how the story began. The cheering crowd from Yohan's victory celebration can be heard in the background. <u>Numbers:</u>

1. Something is not clear - Thomas, Yohan and Adam read Adrian's letter

Scene B:

April 1916, Twenty-three years before, toward the end of the First World War, soldiers on leave are returning from the front, among them Stephan, Adam and Commander Joseph. Leon and Martha arrive to meet Adam. Karl, Stephan's personal assistant arrives at the train station to meet Stephan. Joseph declares Stephan as a war hero who saved him in battle and to whom he owes his life. Stephan and Adam reflect their longing to Adrian. Karl takes Stephan's belongings and puts a coat on him. Stephan bosses him around. In his house, Yohan urges Adrian to marry Stephan and to give up her love for Adam. Yohan's supporters interrupt them, entering his office and Adrian goes out to wait for Adam in the garden.

Numbers:

1. the soldiers are returning from the front – characters exposition at the train station

Scene C:

Yohan assembles a meeting regarding his political moves with his councilors. Adrian secretly meets Adam in Yohan's garden. Stephan, who was on his way to meet Yohan about marring Adrian, sees them. Yohan promises to Josef a senior position in the local police if he will support him in his campaign. Suddenly, a shot is heard from the yard. Everyone runs outside and witness Adam as he is holding a gun leaning over Leon's dead body. Josef arrests him while Adrian is taken away by her father, crying. Adam promises to be back and asks Adrian to wait for him.

Numbers:

- 1. Song of the wealthy
- 2. Adam's arrest.

Scene D :

January 1926, 10 years after, Adam escapes from prison and comes to town disguised as a policeman. He comes to the market to search for Martha. Yohan, the mayor, consult with Stephan on how to get rid of Martha and Karl who now, when Adam is on the run, threatens their reputation. Stefan orders Karl to murder Martha and pays him for the job. Anna witnesses the situation. Karl enlists his friends from the factory for the job. Adam meets Martha in the market and saves her from Karl and his group who get alarmed by the policeman who suddenly appears. Karl and the gang escapes. Adrian and little Tomas witness the event but are too afraid to intervene.

Josef, widowed and poor, is a senior police commander. His daughter, Betty, who is Karl's girlfriend and partner, works in the factory to get money for her poor family. She is part of the group which conspires to kill Martha. Anna runs away from home after her father, Joseph, returns drunk and confronts her and Betty. She meets Tomas on the Street. Adrian sees Adam in the market, but is not sure and tells about it to Stephan. Stephan advises her to write Adam a letter, promising to deliver it to Martha with whom Adam is staying. Martha and Adam disclose to one another the truth about the murder and decide to take action and implicate Stephan instead of Adam.

Numbers :

- 1. The market song
- 2. Every other evening: Joseph and girls. Anna runs away from home.

Scene E :

Without Stephan's knowledge, Adrian sends Tomas to tell Martha about the letter she wrote Adam that waits for her with Stephan. Yohan asks for Adrian's forgiveness for expelling her from his house. Stephan hides Adrian's letter and deliver Adam to the police. On her way to get the letter from Stephan, Martha meets Karl and Betty who strikes her in order to "finish the job". Martha tells Adrian about Adam just before she dies in her arms. Karl updates Stephan on Martha's death and Stephan fires him on the spot. Karl swears to get back at him. Adrian meets Adam, The policeman who where summand by Stephan closes in on Martha's house. Adam is arrested and Adrian gets shot by Joseph and dies before telling him about Tomas, his son. Adam returns to prison and Tomas moves in with Stephan to be raised by him. Numbers:

- 1. Feelings Stephan, Johann, Martha and Adam talk about their feelings.

<u>Act II</u>

Scene A :

April 1916, Martha hears the confession of Stephan in Adrian's garden after the assassination of her husband, Leon. Yohan and Joseph discuss Joseph's appointment as police chief after his discharge from the army. Marta and Adrian confront Yohan, in the heat of their discussion, Adrian tells her father that she is carrying Adam's son. Yohan expels her and Martha from the house. Adrian runs out of the room and meets Stefan in the garden. Stefan reveals his love for her and promises to take care of her in Adam's absence. He supports her until Tomas is born and gives her work in his factory.

Numbers:

- 1. Something is not clear Stephan confesses.
- 2. Stephan, Stephan Stephan, Martha confronts.
- 3. Adrian, Marta and Yohan confrontation.
- 4. Help me Stephan.

Scene B:

February 1939, Twenty Three years later, Yohan declares his intension to run for office as governor with Stephan's support. Karl opposes him and threatens him that he should withdraw his candidacy. He decides to get back at Stephan and Yohan and eliminate their chances to win. He asks Anna to bring Tomas and try to convince him to join their efforts against his father. Karl tells Tomas about what he knows of Leon's murder. Tomas, Anna's lover is the release officer in the local prison. Tomas hears about the gang's plan to blow up the election rally and burn Yohan's house and the city hall next Friday. He confronts them and discovers that Stephan, his step father, paid Karl to get rid of Martha. Tomas and Anna argue about the "truth", Tomas ignores Anna's advances and she runs away.

Numbers:

- 1. The Threat : Speech by Stephan Karl's threat
- 2. Son's of beaches : the gang confronts Thomas
- 3. Hold me : Tomas and Anna

Scene C :

Adam arrives at the parole committee which decides to release him after 23 years inside. He is being processed by Tomas, his son, the release officer. Stephan tells Yohan about his win in the election. Yohan plans his political way. Thomas warns him about Karl's intentions to hurt him.

Numbers:

- 1. Parole committee
- 2. Many years ago

Scene D:

Tomas meets Adam in the prison and promises to help him after his release. The two are not aware that they are farther and son. Tomas asks for Stephan's help in the rehabilitation of Adam with a place to stay and a job at the factory. Betty tries to convince Anna to leave Tomas and join the gang. Karl and his Gang start executing their plan to hurt Yohan and, while trying to break in to his house and burn it, get caught by Joseph. Betty gets shot and killed by her father while trying to save Karl. Anna confronts her father and tells him that she also heard Stephan pay for Martha's murder. Joseph decides to act. Tomas takes Anna and Karl to jail.

Numbers:

- 1. Oh Adrian.
- 2. You must know.
- 3. At the day's end.
- 4. Anna and Betty- Forget him!
- 5. Small rebellion: extradition.
- 6. Anna tells Joseph about Stephan.

Scene E:

March 1939, Anna goes in to jail while Adam is released. Yohan wins the election. A winning party takes place in Stephan's factory instead of the burned city hall. Joseph interrupts the festivities accusing Stephan with murder. At the same time Tomas and Adam enters the hall. Stephan recognizes Adam immediately. He is certain the three of them knows about his past doings and came to arrest him or worse. He escapes to his office and closes the door holding Adrian's letter. Stephan, in an emotional turmoil, is torn between his longing to Adrian and his conscience regarding what happened to Leon and Martha. He feels guilty for Adrian's death. He takes out his gun and kills himself.

Adam, Tomas and Yohan break into his office and find him dead, holding Adrian's letter. Joseph enters the room drawing his gun. Tomas reads in his mother's, Adrian letter which reveal the whole story and the relationship with his true father, Adam and his grandfather Yohan.

Numbers:

- 1. maybe tomorrow
- 2. Background Music: night after night. Stefan enters and applauded.
- 3. Joseph confronts Stefan and it runs away.
- 4. suicide attempted, and the death of Stephan.
- 5. Something is not clear.

Scene F:

April 1916, Adam and Adrian meet in secret in Yohan's garden. Stephan, who came with Karl, overhears them while hiding behind a wooden shrubbery. He is upset and surprised at their manifestations of love. Leon surprises him, the two get into a fight and Stephan accidentally kills Leon with his gun. Karl, waiting for Stephan, sees the murder and flees the scene. Stephan also runs away. Following the shot, Adam arrives and discovers the body of Leon and just as he picks up the gun to see who it belongs to, Yohan and Joseph arrive and catch him in the act. For Yohan, this is an excellent opportunity to get rid of Adam, his daughter suitor, as he intends her for Stephan.

Numbers:

<u>"The solitude of Adam"</u> <u>The main characters in the play</u>

- 1. <u>Adam:</u> Tthe main character. He is a soldier in the army during the First World War. An Orphan, adopted by his aunt and uncle after the death of his parents so he grew up in Yohan Adrian's house, where his aunt and uncle worked as servants. There he met Adrian and the two fell in love. Adam is the biological father of Thomas. He was framed for the murder of his uncle and was sentenced to go to jail.
- 2. <u>Adrian:</u> Yohan's rich and spoiled daughter, has an illicit affair with Adam against her father's wishes. Adrian is Thomas's mother. Naive, kind, humble and willing to give up her status for the sake of true love.
- 3. <u>Stephan:</u> An upper class man that serves as an officer in the army, and is destined to inherited the textile factory from his father. Stefan loves Adrian with all his heart and is willing to give her his life. Stephen is the real assassin of Leon. He is obsessive, prone to depression, loneliness, despair, though kind and decent, a victim of circumstances and of his own doing. An Antihero. After the death of Adrian Stephan adopts Thomas and raises him as if he was his own.
- 4. <u>Yohan</u>: A very wealthy and controversial politician, the father of Adrian and one of notable man of the city, known to be liked and accepted among his peers and he is Martha's master and employer (wife of Leon who murdered by Stefan). Yohan desire to marry Adrian to Stefan is in part because of his desire to run for a more senior position (head of district). The fact that He also holds a key positions in town makes it easier for him to shorten procedures for Adam's arrest. He is a vain, materialistic, protective of his status and honor but at the same time, attentive to the public, and moderated and conservative in his views.
- 5. <u>Thomas</u>: Adam and Adrian's son. grew up with Stephen after Adrian died. He does not know that his real father is Adam until the day that Stephen commits suicide. As an adult he becomes a senior officer in the County Jail, favored by the prisoners due to his concern for them. When show of force starts in the streets, Thomas, with the help of his adoptive father, Stephen, comes to Yohan's defense, preventing his murder. Thomas is a childhood friend of Anna. A gentle soul, a pacifist, childish and naive.
- 6. <u>Leon:</u> Adam's uncle a servant of Adrian's family for many years. Married to Martha. Murdered by Stephen during a confrontation between them in Yohan's back yard.

- 7. <u>Martha</u>: Leon's wife. Her name was smothered by Yohan and his people to silence her and prevent a scandal following the murder that took place in Yohan's back yard. A Victim of circumstances who lost all her hope, and trust in people. A bitter, melancholic person though, a pure soul. The only glimmer of light comes to her life through helping Adam and by clearing his name and hers too in the process. She is full of longing and memories of her past.
- 8. <u>Anna:</u> Thomas's childhood friend, daughter of Police Chief Joseph, an orphan raised by her father and her older sister. She is torn between her love for Thomas and her loyalty to her sister, between the rebellious Karl's anarchists world and the law and order, represented by Thomas and his father. Anna's sister, Betty, is Karl's girlfriend.
- 9. <u>Betty:</u> Anna's older sister, one of the leaders of the group of Workers (Communists). Violent, cheeky and independent. With radical views. She is in love with Karl who took care of her in the past.
- 10. **Karl:** The leader of workers group, a violent person and extremely vindictive who was once Stefan's personal servant and left him to plan and lead acts of violence in the name of workers fired from Stefan's factory. Karl was hired by Stefan and Yohan to hurt Martha, each with their own individual motive. His hatred of the wealthy, upper class, fuels his plans to harm Yohan.
- 11. **Joseph:** Yohan and Stefan's close friend, the father of Betty and Anna. Was the army commander of Adam and Stefan and was appointed by Yohan as the chief of police. Joseph, who uncovered Stephan's crimes, goes after him despite great risk to his status, position and the relationship with his daughters.



- Act 1 -



Scene A

The curtain rises on the setting of Stephan's fancy office. The year is 1939 somewhere in Europe at Night. In the background the sounds of a party. On stage are Adam as an elderly man dressed in a long raincoat, Tomas, the young officer in his uniform. Beside them, stunned, stands Yohan. And in front of them, Stephan, seated on his chair, his head lying on the desk in a paddle of blood. In one hand he holds a gun and in the other he has a letter. Joseph stands in the entrance with a drawn gun pointed towards Stephan.

Tomas approaches Stephen, taking the letter from his hand and reads it along with Adam. They sing:

The lights are fading out. The train platform is getting on the stage. Side stage, Yohan and Adrian argue in Yohan's office. A loud whistle symbols the train entrance to the station. It starts a fuss on the stage.

Scene B

1916. A train station in the middle of Europe, during the First World War, Soldiers are coming back from the front. Among them Adam, Stephan and Josef. Martha and Leon, Adam's only family, are coming to pick him up. Karl, Stephan's assistant, comes to pick him up, holding his coat. Yohan and Adrian stands on an elevated podium – Yohan's office.

The platform fill with people, the soldiers are coming out one by one.

- A newspaper boy: April 11th, 1916; Our men have defeated the British expeditionary forces, and thousands of soldiers are returning home on leave. Karl, arrive to the platform to meat Stephan the war hero. Across from them on the platform, stand Leon and Martha, their servants. They are waiting for Adam, their orphan nephew, who has also come home from the battlefield. Yohan intends Adrian for Stephan. He does not approve of her love for Adam. Stephan does not know about Adrian's secret love for Adam and waits to meet her. Read all about it in today's paper!
- **Boy 1:** The soldiers are returning from the front It's been a year since they were home
- Girl 1:And on their backs a heavy load residesThose who still lives, and those who diedTogether:Unload the burden now is the time
- Live every day like it's your last
- **The band:**Tomorrow we will go there againThe future holds a better past
- Leon: It`s been too long, I wonder how he looks Is he O.K.? Is he in pain?
- Martha: They change forever when they go to war A tender boy becomes a man
 - We raised him just like one of our own We promised them before they died
- Yohan:[To Adrian]I want you to consider StephanI'm sure you`ll be a perfect bride
- Adrian: But I have set my sights on Adam He fills my heart with love and joy
- Yohan: This is the last time that I tell you You`ll never wed a stable boy You`ll never wed a stable boy!

In the garden, Stephan, shocked of his own doing, arrives to the murder scene to look for evidence he might have left behind, still wearing his uniform.

All the lights go dark on the stage. A single white spot lights Stephan. He is standing at the side of the stage. He sings and advances slowly to the center, where Adam and Adrian stood before. Martha enters the garden and stands behind Stephan without him noticing her.

Stephan: Nothing is clear to me How could it ever be? What am I doing, God In this place?

> Waking up from a dream? What has just happened here Who is to blame? Me? Or is it him?

All of these days of war life that I had before Seems like a different time Different men

Yet it is I, not him That`s why the shame`s on me How could I`ve killed him, How I`ve shot him....

Hh...Ma`am?

Stephan sees that he is not alone.

February 1929, Twenty three years after the murder and thirteen years after Adrian's death, Adam is about to be released from jail. Tomas, his son, is 23, raised by Stephan since Adrian's death and he loves and adores him like a father. Yohan still ignores Tomas and doesn't know that Stephan is raising him, runs for Governor after his term as mayor and pushes for Stephan's nomination as the new mayor. Karl and his gang want to revenge Stephan and Yohan for what they have done by sabotage their campaign. They decide to turn Tomas against Stephan, to threaten him and to burn down Yohan's house at the time of the winning gala. Tomas serves in the local police as a captain with the district jail where Adam serves his time. The two don't know anything about their family relationship, but they do know each other from the daily routine in prison. In the background economic conditions are getting worse and as a result, so is the hatred toward foreigners. The curtain rises over the city's main square.

Yohan and Josef come running in.

Adam points at a chair and tells Tomas:

- Adam: Grab the chair Break it down Something`s wrong, there`s no sound!
- Tomas: Both of us Smash the door Once again - like before Let`s g.....

[gun shot]

The two, finally, break the door open only to find Stephan lying in a pool of blood. In one hand, a gun and in the other one, Adrian's letter which tells the life story of Tomas and Adam and connects them as father and son. Tomas reads the letter and passes it to Adam. Adam reads it too. This is in fact the first scene of the musical.

- Tomas:Nothing is clear to me
How could it ever be
Everything I have known seems to fall
Some kind of memory
Lost in a mystery
How do a son and father lose it all
- Adam:Hard to connect the dots

Adrian waits in the garden and Adam, who has just now returned for a vacation from the army, slips in secretly, hugs her, and pledge their love to one another not knowing that Stephan is eavesdropping on their conversation from behind a bush. Their relationship is a forbidden one and only Martha and Leon share the secret. Karl is waiting for Stephan at the edge of the stage.

Blue lights, late at night. Adam enters the stage wearing his uniform and Adrian holds him.
